

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at JFK fell by 89.4 percent – the sharpest decline among our top airports (-5.382 million passengers). The international sector (accounting for more than half of JFK's total passenger activity) saw its passenger volume sink by 92.7 percent (-3.194 million travelers). Delta, JetBlue, American, Norwegian and British Airways accounted for the majority of the losses as they jointly transported 1.421 million fewer passengers. Domestic passenger traffic at JFK plunged 85.1 percent (-2.188 million travelers). Delta, JetBlue and American posted a combined loss of 2.049 million travelers. JFK's total freight activity saw a 20.2 percent drop (-21,961 short tons). As in the previous five months, the fall was entirely driven by the international sector's fifth successive double-digit decrease (-39.7 percent/-33,867 short tons), while domestic cargo improved. JFK saw its domestic cargo activity post its second consecutive double-digit surge (+50.6 percent/+11,906 tons).
