MAY 2020 TRAFFIC REPORT

Total passenger activity posted a 97.5 percent dive (-5.451 million travelers). The international segment (accounting for approximately 55 percent of JFK's total passenger activity) declined 98.6 percent (-3.023 million travelers). Delta (-534,139 passengers/-99.8 percent); JetBlue (-328,984 passengers/-97.8 percent); American (-185,454 passengers/-100 percent); British Airways (-130,334 passengers/-97.8 percent) and Norwegian (-129,962 passengers/-100 percent) led the plunge as they jointly carried 1.309 million fewer travelers. JFK's domestic passenger volume registered a 96.2 percent tumble (-2.428 million travelers). Delta (-1.076 million passengers/-97.98 percent), JetBlue (-870,622 passengers/-95 percent) and American (-340,962 passengers/-95.9 percent) led the drop. Total cargo activity fell 25.8 percent (-30,368 tons). The loss was wholly due to the international sector's 19th consecutive monthly loss (-35.7 percent/-32,378 short tons), as JFK was the only facility to show improved domestic cargo activity (+7.5 percent/+2,010 tons).
