Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic fell by 80.6 percent (-3.701 million passengers), practically tied with LGA for the second-largest decline after SWF. The international sector (typically accounting for more than half of JFK's total passenger activity) saw its passenger volume sink by 84 percent (-2.035 million travelers). Delta, JetBlue, American, Norwegian and British Airways accounted for most of the losses as they jointly transported 815,077 fewer passengers. Domestic passenger traffic at JFK plunged 76.86 percent (-1.666 million travelers). Delta, JetBlue and American posted a combined loss of 1.507 million travelers. JFK's total freight activity was roughly flat compared to November 2019. Gains in domestic cargo (+13,296/59.2 percent) more than offset declines in international cargo (-12,958 short tons/-14.2 percent).
