LGA's total passenger volume posted a 98.6 percent plummet (-2.610 million travelers). The domestic segment saw 2.431 fewer travelers (down 98.5 percent – the highest rate of decline among our airports). Delta (-1.112 million travelers/-98.9 percent), American (-626,196 passengers/-97.7 percent), Southwest (-231,144 passengers/-97.7 percent) and United (-219,963 passengers/-99.1 percent) led the decrease with a combined 2.19-million-passenger deficit. LGA's international passenger traffic (which has been underperforming for sixth consecutive months) registered a 99.9 percent nosedive (down 178,508 travelers). Air Canada was the only carrier with international passenger activity, moving just 125 travelers, down 92,319 passengers from April 2019 (-99.9 percent). In April 2019, WestJet (45,130 passengers), American (22,443 passengers) and Delta (18,616 passengers) together handled 86,189 travelers. LGA was the only facility to record an improvement in cargo activity, though at a modest pace (+0.9 percent/+5 tons).
