

## Aviation Department

Total passenger activity at LGA recorded an 87.4 percent drop (-2.472 million travelers). The domestic sector saw its passenger traffic decline by 86.6 percent (-2.266 million travelers). Delta (-1.044 million passengers/-90.2 percent), American (-596,569 passengers/-85.1 percent), United (-215,891 passengers/-91.1 percent) and Southwest (-205,820 passengers/-78.6 percent) together carried 2.062 million fewer travelers. LGA's international passenger segment served 205,763 fewer travelers (-98.1 percent). As in the previous three months, Air Canada was the only carrier with international passenger activity as it transported just 3,923 passengers (-114,346 travelers/-96.7 percent). In July 2019, WestJet (52,877 passengers), Delta (22,580 passengers) and American (15,960 passengers) jointly served 91,417 international travelers. Following two consecutive monthly double-digit tumbles, LGA's total freight activity posted a 4.4 percent improvement (+21 tons).
