

## Aviation Department

Total passenger activity recorded a 96.9 percent decrease (-2.772 million travelers). The domestic sector handled 2.572 million fewer travelers – down 96.6 percent. Delta (-1.165 million passengers/-98.3 percent), American (-667,391 passengers/-93.6 percent), Southwest (-244,241 passengers/-96.5 percent) and United (-232,119 passengers/-94.9 percent) jointly carried 2.308 million fewer travelers. LGA's international sector handled 200,167 fewer passengers (-99.8 percent). As in the month of April, Air Canada was the only carrier with international passenger activity, carrying 352 passengers (-110,004 passengers/-99.7 percent). In May 2019, WestJet (53,029 travelers), Delta (21,239 travelers) and American (15,895 travelers) jointly served 90,163 passengers. Following five consecutive monthly gains, LGA's total cargo volume landed in negative territory (-56.8 percent/-311 tons).
