

# THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ

## NOVEMBER 2020 TRAFFIC REPORT

Total passenger activity recorded an 82 percent drop (-2.033 million travelers). The domestic sector saw its passenger traffic decline by 80.9 percent (-1.868 million travelers). Delta (-847,107 passengers/-84.5 percent), American (-496,113 passengers/-82 percent), Southwest (-210,309 passengers/-83.4 percent), and United (-139,006 passengers/-75.6 percent) together carried 1.482 million fewer travelers compared to November 2019. LGA's international passenger segment served 164,500 fewer travelers (-97.1 percent). Air Canada and WestJet recorded international passenger activity of 5,004 passengers (-131,603 travelers/-96.3 percent). LGA's total freight activity dipped again, registering a drop of -16.8 percent (-105 short tons) compared to November 2019.
