Total passenger activity at LGA recorded an 83.5 percent drop (-2.231 million travelers). The domestic sector saw its passenger traffic decline by 64.5 percent (-1.815 million travelers). Delta (-911,741 passengers/-85.3 percent), American (-569,347 passengers/-82.3 percent), Southwest (-201,941 passengers/-81.8 percent), and United (-165,279 passengers/-76.3 percent) together carried 1.848 million fewer travelers compared to October 2019. LGA's international passenger segment served 189,985 fewer travelers (-96.9 percent). Air Canada and WestJet recorded international passenger activity of 6,188 passengers (-151,870 travelers/-96.1 percent). LGA's total freight activity dipped again, registering a drop of -22.3 percent (-140 short tons) compared to October 2019.
