The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey offers the E-ZPass electronic toll collection system in all toll lanes at its tunnels and bridges. Businesses can save money whenever they use E-ZPass, but especially during off-peak and weekday overnight hours. The E-ZPass overnight toll rate for trucks offers a discount of more than 20% off the Tolls by Mail rate. Please note all E-ZPass discounts offered at Port Authority of New York and New Jersey bridges and tunnels apply to accounts at the E-ZPass New York and New Jersey Customer Service Centers only.

To incentivize proper positioning of E-ZPass Tags, the Port Authority introduced a new Mid-Tier toll rate effective, July 6, 2025. This new tier is intended for NY/NJ E-ZPass account customers to take advantage of lower E-ZPass rates by ensuring their Tags are mounted properly. If the Tag is not accurately read by the toll collection system at the time of crossing, the Mid-Tier toll rate will be applied to cover the incremental cost to process the toll transaction (license plate picture and account verification).

E-ZPass eliminates the need for receipts, because periodic statements are issued. Businesses can request online statements for easier sorting and recordkeeping.

E-ZPass is accepted in 19 states by 32 toll operators from Maine to Florida, and as far west as Minnesota. More states may join in the future. E-ZPass tag holders may use their tag wherever the E-ZPass logo is displayed.

All Port Authority crossings are cashless and no longer accept cash toll payments. Toll payment is accepted via E-ZPass tag or Tolls by Mail.

All vehicles using Port Authority crossings are subject to search by Port Authority Police and other designated authorized officials.

RESTRICTIONS

George Washington Bridge

ALL TRUCKS must use the upper level of the George Washington Bridge. Violators subject to summons and/or fine. Starting Monday, December 9, 2024, and until further notice, new 179th St. westbound ramp vehicle restrictions of 10' width and 110' length will be in effect.

All NY bound commercial vehicles needing to access local Fort Lee streets should use the I-95 Express Lane/Upper-Level Exit 73 approach. Commercial vehicles approaching from either I-95 Local, NJ 4, or U.S. 46 should stay towards the left and then use the Upper-Level/I-95 Express Lane approach to Exit 73. Commercial vehicles are urged to avoid using I-95 Local Lane/Lower-Level Exit 73 approach.

Holland Tunnel

The following restrictions are in place until further notice:

In Both Directions: NO TRACTOR-TRAILERS, THREE-AXLE DUAL-UNIT TRUCKS, OR TRUCKS WITH FOUR OR MORE AXLES PERMITTED. Only two and three-axle single-unit trucks are allowed.

Lincoln Tunnel

NO TRUCKS permitted in the Center Tube of the Lincoln Tunnel.

Propane Restrictions

Propane may not be transported through the Lincoln or Holland tunnels or across the Lower Level of the George Washington Bridge.

Speed Limits

Speed limits vary by facility. You must obey all posted speed limits at our crossings.

Motorists who speed risk fine and/or summons, points on their license, as well as the suspension or revocation of E-ZPass privileges.

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George Washington Bridge

Upper Level*	13 feet 6 inches
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Lincoln Tunnel*	13 feet
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Holland Tunnel*	12 feet 6 inches
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Goethals Bridge	13 feet 6 inches
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Outerbridge Crossing	13 feet 6 inches
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Bayonne Bridge*	13 feet 6 inches
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If you are uncertain of the height of your vehicle, avoid problems - USE A BRIDGE.

Width Limits

Overall body widths for vehicles without safety devices:

George Washington Bridge	10 feet
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Lincoln Tunnel*	8 feet 6 inches
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Holland Tunnel*	8 feet
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Goethals Bridge	8 feet 6 inches
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Outerbridge Crossing	8 feet 6 inches
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Bayonne Bridge*	8 feet 6 inches

Oversized Vehicles

All oversize vehicles must have a Port Authority Police escort. Operators of oversized vehicles must call the applicable Facility Communications Desk (see *Important Telephone Numbers* section on back cover) prior to trip for approval.

The toll for oversized vehicles is double the established toll rate. Oversized vehicles are subject to an escort fee of \$40.00 (escort fee subject to change).
