

PATH On-Track Safety Program

PATH requires that all tenant personnel who may enter the track area at any time be certified by successfully completing the "PATH ON-TRACK SAFETY PROGRAM", in compliance with the Rules and Regulations set forth in Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) Regulations 49 CFR Part 214, Subpart C, entitled "Railroad Worker Protection". Tenant personnel not certified under this program will not be permitted to enter the PATH track area. On a monthly basis, PATH will provide a four-hour certification class at no cost to the Tenant, which includes a certification test for supervisory staff representing the Tenant. The Tenant's supervisory staff will then be required to train and certify all additional personnel that may be performing work for the Tenant. A letter certifying that the listed Tenant personnel have been trained on the PATH On-Track Safety Program and, that they fully understand and will comply with all FRA rules, shall be filled with PATH Tenant Facility Office (TFO) at One PATH Plaza, Jersey City, NJ 07306-2905, Eighth Floor, within 48 hours of such training. Only the person specified in such a letter will be permitted to enter the track area.
