The following questions are from RFP recipients. The questions and the corresponding Authority answers are provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

**Question #1:** Can you confirm if survey of the two sites will be provided by the Authority or if it will be part of the selected Consultant's scope.

Answer #1: Condition survey for the stations was performed in Stage I and documented in the Stage I Report. The selected Consultant will need to verify the stations existing condition(s) and determine if additional field survey is needed. Refer to the Attachment A, Page 12, Task B. Field Verification Surveys for details. Topographic survey of the stations was not performed during Stage I design. However, topographic survey of other projects in Hoboken and Newport Stations was done and will be provided to the selected Consultant. The selected Consultant will need to verify the existing condition against the topographic survey provided from other projects.

**Question #2:** Many of the available documents for Newport contain information at the platform level, however the RFP scope of work is defined at the upper mezzanine only. In general, please confirm that the scope in the RFP documents covers the full scope of work intended? For example, an available document was provided for additional stair and side platform access, which is outside of the scope defined in the RFP.

<u>Answer #2:</u> For scope of services, please refer to Attachment A, Pages 3 – 8, item A through N. The intent to provide Contract PAT-684.015 – *Newport Station – Additional Stair and Elevator to Side Platform* is to let prospect proposers understand that the station was built in a different period of time and allow judgment to perform the scope of services.

The date for receipt of proposals for the subject RFP remains 2:00 P.M. on September 13, 2019.
