The following questions were received from a Request for Proposals (RFP) recipient(s). The questions and the corresponding Authority answers are provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

Question 1: Our services would fit under Section D.1., which refers to FAA Order 1050.1F. More specifically, the Order includes underground storage tank (UST) system closures in section 5-6.4u USTs and environmental investigations and remediations in Sections 5-6z.ee and z.ff. Why are these services under an "exclusion" section of the Order. Could you clarify what they are excluded from and whether or not they are part of the services that will be included under the RFP?

Answer 1: Chapter 5 of FAA order 10501F deals with projects that the FAA has determined do not, individually or cumulatively, have a significant effect on the human environment. This means that the actions listed in paragraph 5-6.4U would be excluded from the requirement to conduct a formal Environmental Assessment (EA). An EA will only be required if other Extraordinary Circumstances that may have significant environmental impact exist (see paragraph 5.2 of the Order).
