**Contract PAT-774.178 – PATH – Hack West Crossover and Replacement of Track and Turnouts at Kearny Pocket.** Estimate Range: \$20M - \$30M. **Bids Due: Thursday, December 19, 2019.** The work under this contract consists generally of removal and replacement of existing track and turnouts and related work in open track areas at Kearny Pocket, Hack West (main line track west of Hackensack River Lift Bridge) and the vicinities thereof in Hudson County, New Jersey. This project may be Federally funded in whole or in part. Accordingly, all bidders and the successful Contractor will be required to comply with any and all required applicable federal provisions and requirements contained in this solicitation and resulting contract. This Contract contains Prerequisites:

- A.) The bidder must be able to demonstrate the following in 1.) through 3.) below. The bidder may also qualify for 1.) through 3.) below, if the bidder or persons or entities owning and controlling the bidding firm shall have satisfactorily met the requirements as owning and controlling another firm.
  - 1.) That the bidder has a minimum of ten (10) years of continuous experience as a prime contractor performing work comparable in size, type and complexity to the Work in this Contract within the previous ten (10) years.
  - 2.) That the bidder has substantially completed on time at least two (2) contracts comparable in size, type and complexity to the Work in this Contract within the previous fifteen (15) years.
  - 3.) That the bidder's full-time Project Manager and Superintendent shall each have a minimum of ten (10) years construction experience on contracts comparable in type, size and complexity to the Work in this Contract, and each shall have acted as Project Manager and Superintendent respectively on at least one project comparable in size, type and complexity to the Work of this Contract.
