**DESCRIPTION:** The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey is seeking proposals from qualified firms to provide, implement and maintain a best-in-class body worn camera system consisting of approximately 2,000 body-worn cameras for use by the Port Authority Police Department, associated accessories (mounts, docking stations, etc.), and an associated fully hosted cloud-based (software as a service) solution for the storage, management and display of video and audio captured by the cameras. The selected body worn camera system shall be durable, reliable, easy, and safe to use, and have a proven track record of capturing and securely storing video and audio recordings of interactions.
