- 1) **Please Note:** The due date for receipt of Proposals has been changed to 2:00 p.m., January 9, 2020.
- 2) In the RFP Letter, after the second paragraph, insert the following:
 - "Proposers are advised that performance of the services contemplated hereunder shall give rise to the existence, or the appearance, of a conflict of interest, and accordingly, the firm(s) selected for performance of the subject services will be expressly precluded from participation in, or the performance of, other PATH Fare Payment Integration Program contracting opportunities. Your attention is further directed to paragraph 30 of the attached standard Agreement."
- 3) In the Attachment A, Section II. Scope of Work, delete the last paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following:
 - "The Consultant providing Program Management services under this task shall be able to work autonomously and proactively to determine what is required to maintain the Program schedule, budget and scope. It is anticipated that the Consultant's personnel shall be working at the Journal Square Technical Center, in Jersey City, New Jersey. If directed by the Authority, the Consultant's staff shall perform selected tasks at the Consultant's offices."
- 4) In the standard Agreement, insert the following after the second paragraph:
 - "The Authority has determined that the performance of the services contemplated hereunder shall give rise to the existence, or the appearance, of a conflict of interest, and accordingly, the Consultant is expressly precluded from participation in, or the performance of, other PATH Fare Payment Integration Program contracting opportunities."
