MWSDBE Certification Requirements

Requirements to become MBE, WBE or MWBE certified with the Port Authority:

The following includes some of the main requirements necessary to become MWBE certified.

- Must be at least 1 year in business.
- Must be at least 51% Minority and/or Women owned and controlled depending on which program the application is for.

Requirements to become SBE certified with the Port Authority:

In order to qualify for SBE certification, your firm must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- Must be at least 3 years in business.
- Main office must be located in New York or New Jersey.
- Must not exceed the 3-year gross receipt capacity specified by industry.
 - o Accounting/Auditing Services: \$20.5 Million
 - Architectural Services: \$7.5 Million
 - o Commodity: \$7.5 Million
 - Construction: \$36.5 Million
 - Engineering Services: \$15 Million
 - Financial Services: \$7.5 Million
 - o General Management Consulting Services: \$15 Million
 - o Janitorial Maintenance: \$18 Million
 - Technology Services: \$27.5 Million

Requirements to become DBE/ACDBE certified:

The following includes some of the main requirements necessary to become DBE/ACDBE certified.

- Must be at least 1 day in business.
- Must be at least 51% owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals.
- The firm (including its affiliates) must be a small business as defined by SBA standards and have average annual gross receipts not to exceed \$23.98 million. Size limits for the airport concessions DBE program are higher.
- Owner must have a personal net worth that does not exceed \$1.32 million.
- The business must not be tied to another firm in such a way as to compromise its independence and control.
