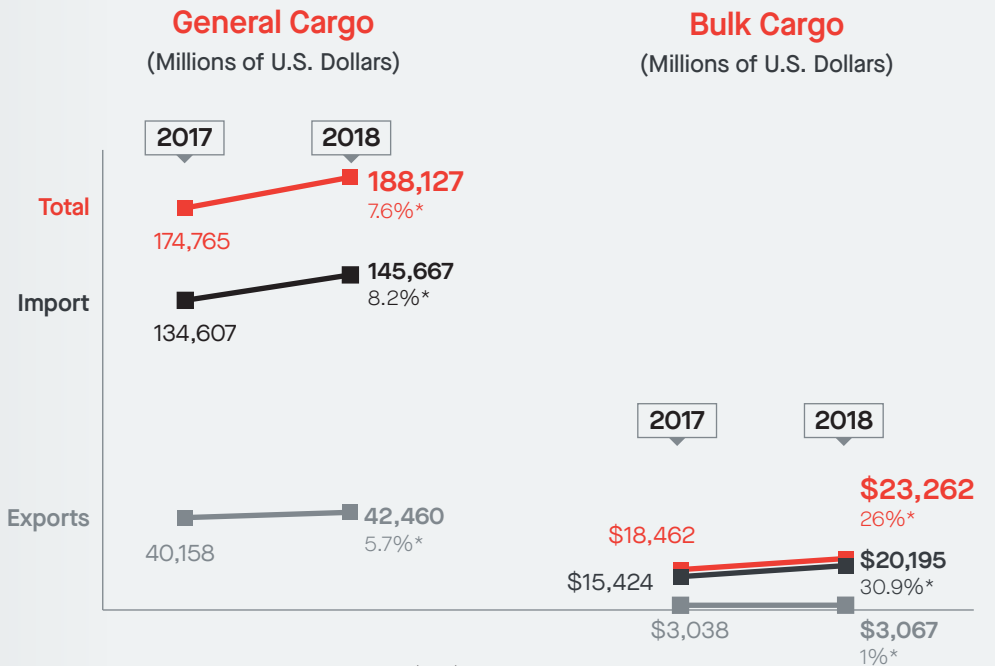

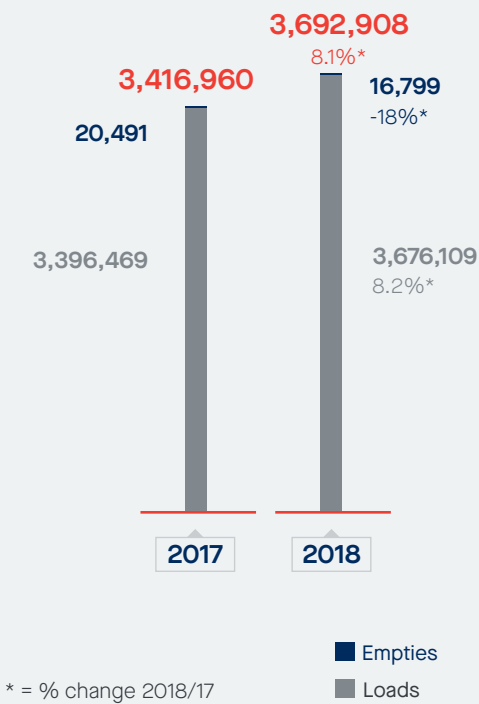

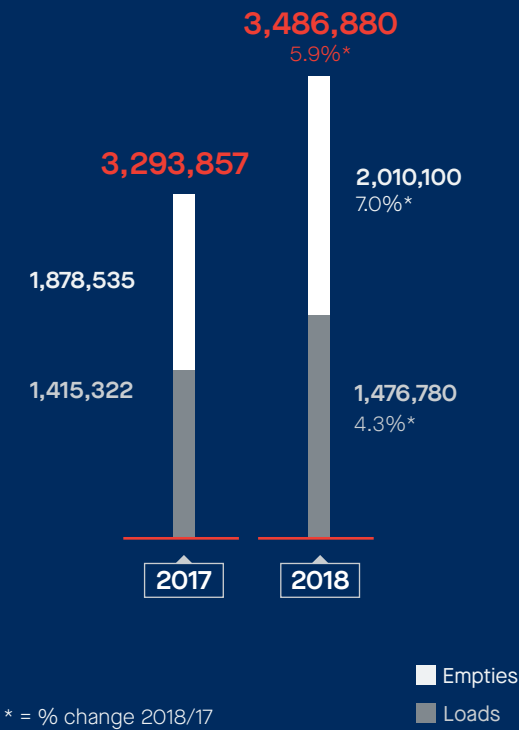

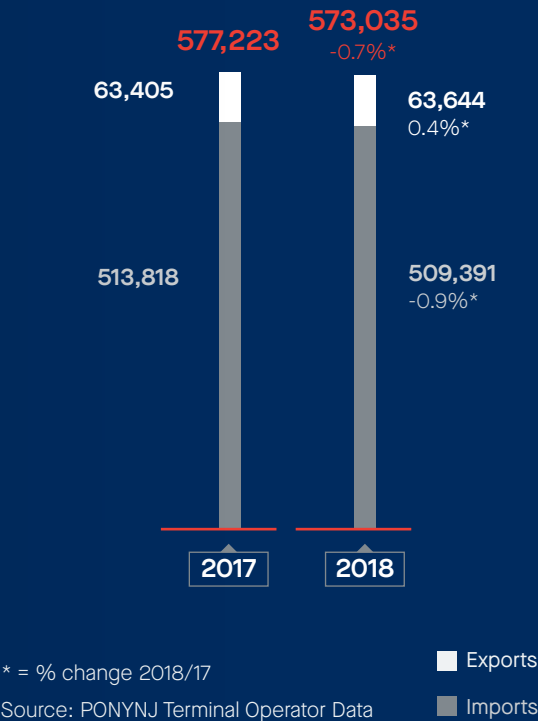

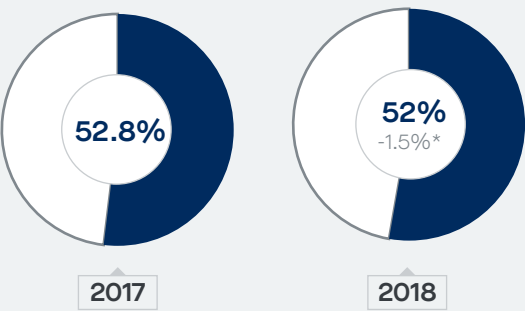

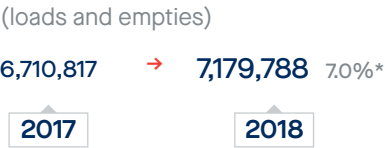


Market Share, Loaded & Empty TEUs

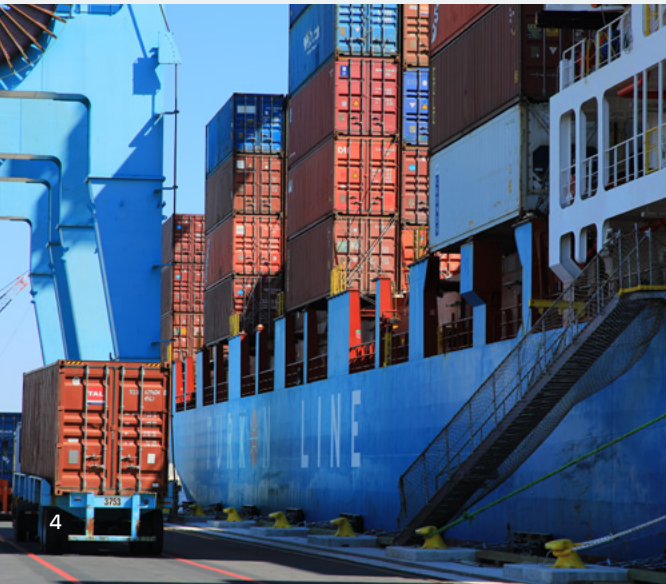
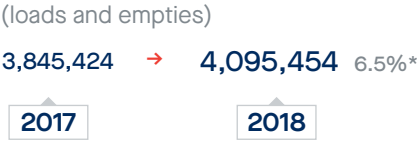
North Atlantic Share

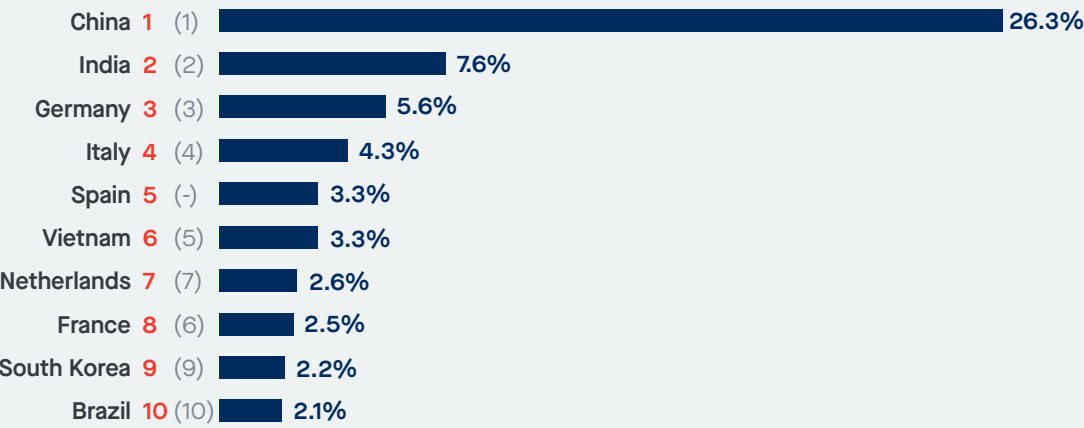

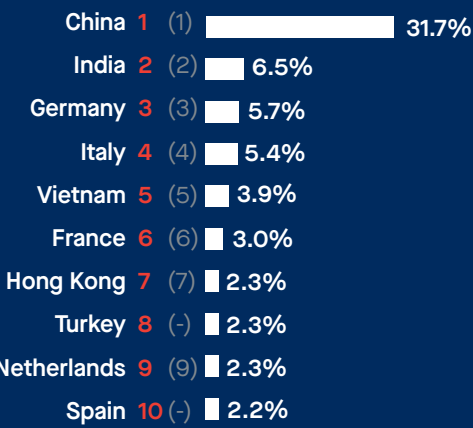
2018 Total Volume (Imports/Exports)

2018 Import Volume

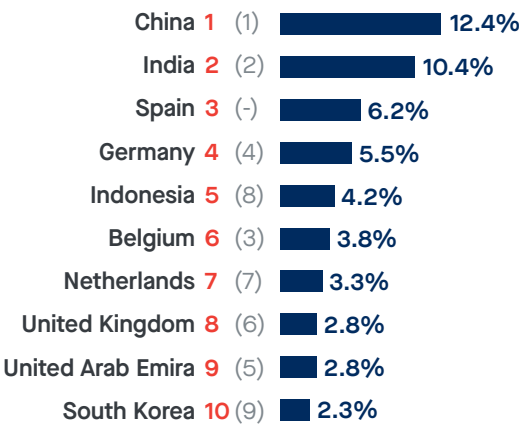

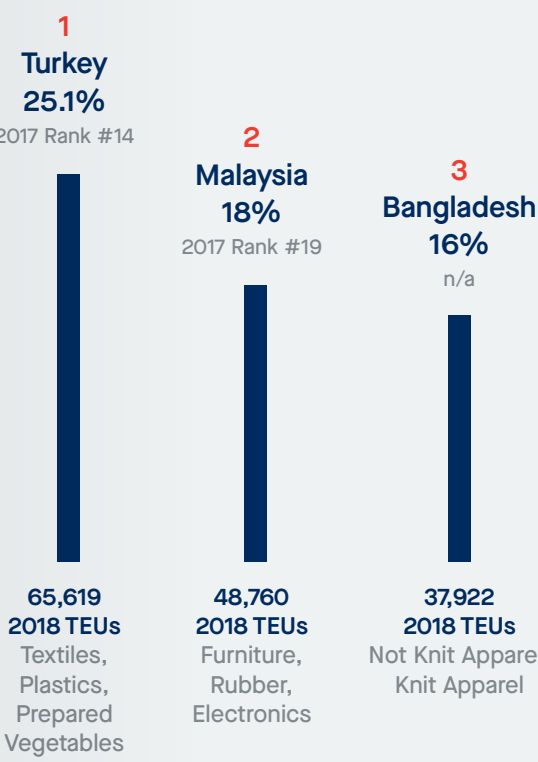

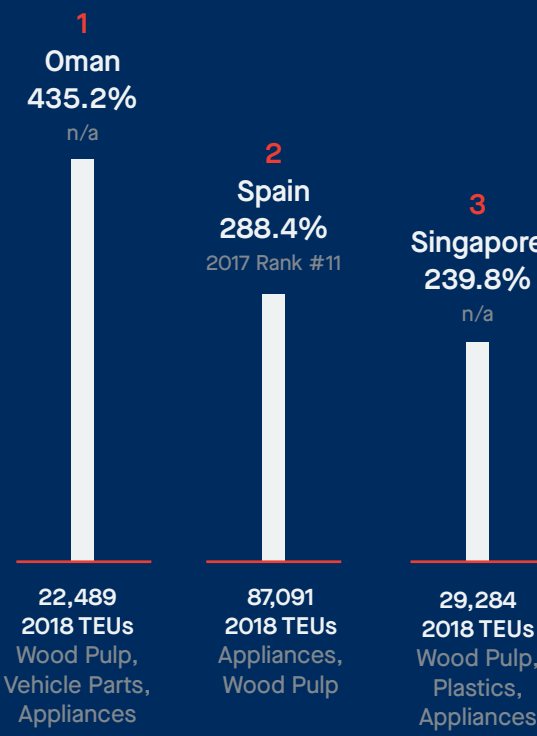
Growth over 2017

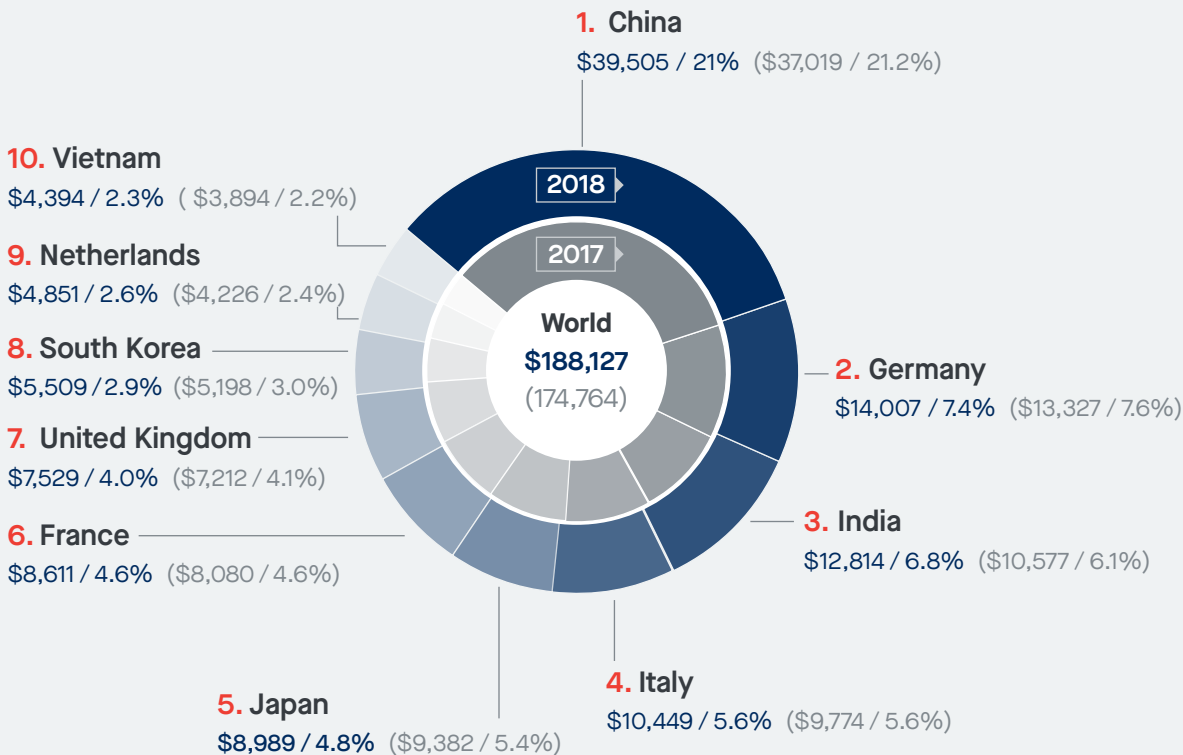
Growth over 2016



Share of Total U.S. General Cargo

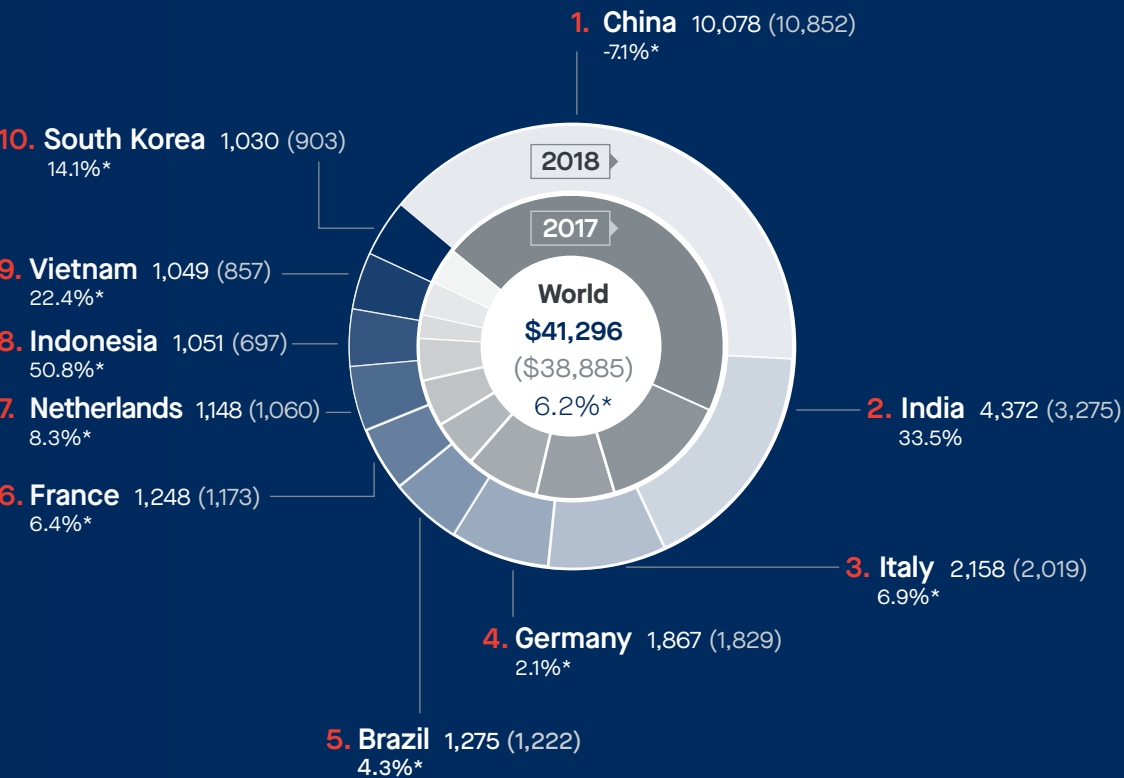
2018 Top 10 Trading Partners by Value

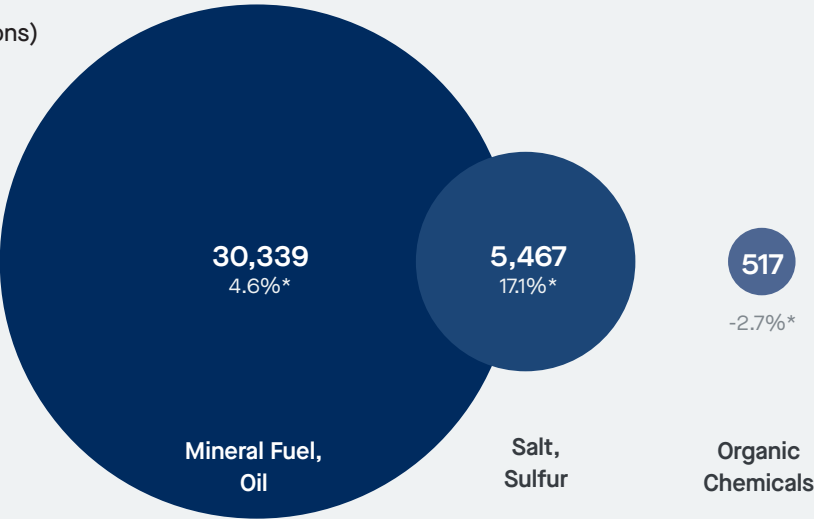

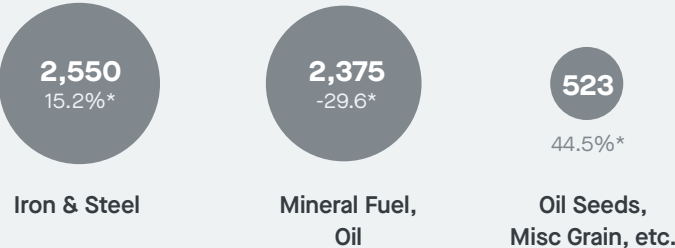

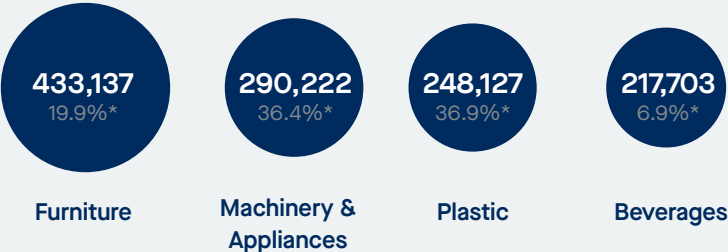

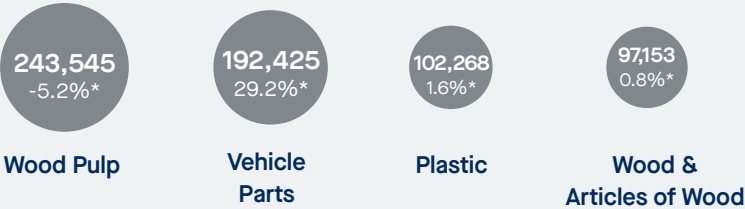

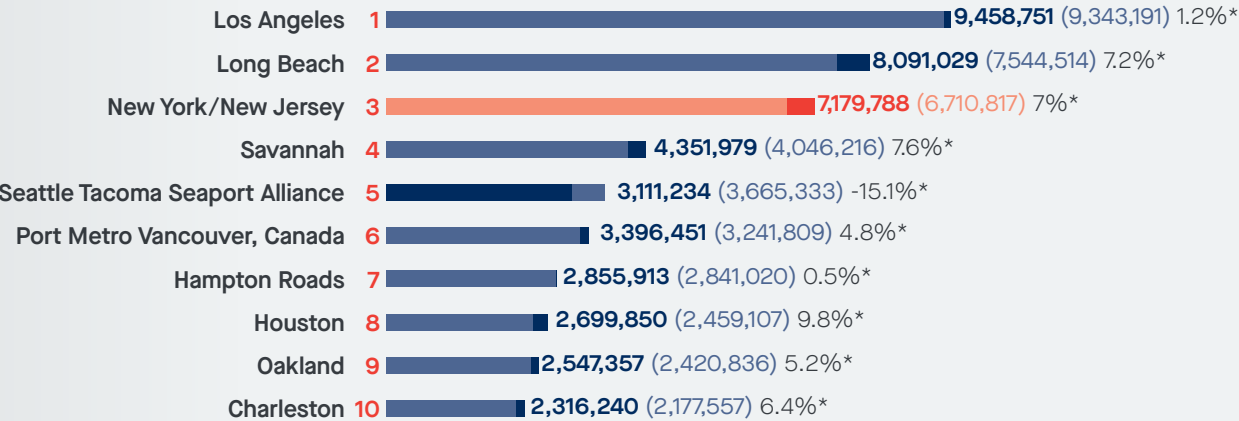

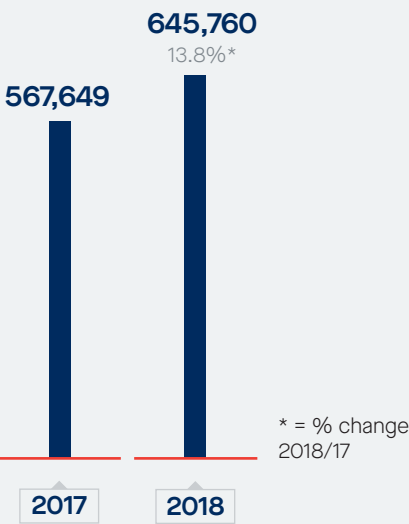
