







Top 10 Trading Partners




2018 Export Volume








Share of Total U.S. General Cargo

2018 Top 10 Trading Partners by Value


Millions of US Dollars 2018 (2017)






2018 Port Volume Rankings

2018 Total Volume (Imports/Exports)


Top 10 North America, U.S. unless otherwise noted 2018 (2017)
