Dear Jason:

I am writing you in relation to the infractions listed below of Mr. Hussen, who is the operator of SuperShuttle Van 714. Mr. Hussen has continued, on a number of occasions, to solicit passengers within the Terminal areas at LaGuardia Airport. At one point, Mr. Anthony Callender, of my staff, suspended Mr. Hussen for such activity. Please review the following list of infractions that have been reported to the Port Authority;

- On January 23, 2010, Gateway employee at LaGuardia Airport named Mandit, contacted the SuperShuttle Manager on Duty, Randy Aguilar, to inform him that Mr. Hussen was soliciting passengers from US Air. She stated that this is not the first time Mr. Hussen has solicited passengers in the terminal and that he is on a "watch list" for possible overcharges to customers.
- On September 7, 2010, Gateway employee Benjamin Del Rio witnessed Mr. Hussen soliciting passengers at the East Wing at LGA. This report was faxed to SuperShuttle and the Port Authority suspended the driver for 3 days. The suspension was to be longer because of the previous incident on January 23, 2010 but the Port Authority gave Mr. Hussen consideration.
- On February 27, 2011, Gateway employee, Yousaf Richa, witnessed Mr. Hussen at the East Wing at LGA interrupt two presentations given to two separate passengers to attempt to solicit them before booking the reservations at the counter. This report was faxed to SuperShuttle along with a follow up email as to the action we are taking against Mr. Hussen due to his continual issues with soliciting at LGA.

Based on the multiple infractions listed above, Van 714 will be suspended indefinitely from the Port Authority of NY and NJ Shared Ride Permittee Program.
