

Good Day,

I have some clarifications for some of the questions that came up yesterday.

- 1) Cold ironing land side infrastructure may trigger a NEPA review.
- 2) There is no identified oldest model year for truck replacement - the applicant can choose to replace older trucks with any age truck.
- 3) Region 2's funding cap will remain at \$7M.
- 4) The remaining 75% on the truck replacement cannot be covered with the loan program. For the repowers and replacements, there is an understood match requirement. The applicant needs to show that they have direct access (money in hand) to the capital cost portion that is not covered with the federal money. This match cannot be federal money such as CMAQ or money from another federal grant, like the loan program grant.
