

Recommendation

- Authorize Phase I planning to define requirements for various airport facilities as well as planning for enhanced capacity on the AirTrain JFK system at an estimated cost of \$5 million
- Authorize the Executive Director to enter into professional technical services agreements to advance the planning effort, on a task order basis.

Background

- 75 million passengers by 2032
- AirTrain JFK ridership exceeds 2023 forecast
- Visioning/master planning effort underway
